My husband, David Kelton, and I have lived in the Prestonwood Estates neighborhood for 24 years. We raised our two sons here and they attended school in the Richardson School District.


David is a candidate for Judge of the 134th District Court in Dallas County, and is on the Democratic ballot. A summary of his qualifications and experience is attached.
